





Zarafa Camp & Dhow Suites at Zarafa

Located in the game rich Selinda Reserve in the Okavango, award winning Zarafa Camp is synonymous with exclusivity and perfection. The spirit behind Zarafa Camp comes from Dereck and Beverly Joubert who designed Zarafa to incorporate all the components of what they envisioned as the 'perfect' and totally 'green' safari camp.

Dhow Suites at Zarafa Lodge is one of the largest tents ever built in Africa. It has its own private vehicle, safari guide, chef and manager with two main bedroom tents, a central living and dining area as well as its own pool and fireplace. Each bedroom tent has a copper bath and outdoor shower overlooking the lagoon. Evening private dining is either outside under the stars or in the private dining room featuring fine wines and Relais & Châteaux cuisine.



Selinda Camp and Selinda Suite

On the banks of the eastern Selinda Spillway in the 320,000-acre Selinda Reserve of northern Botswana. This prime location is deep within rich wildlife territory.

Selinda Explorers Camp

About an hour's game drive west of Selinda Camp lies Selinda Explorers Tented Camp. Poised in a remote, treasured location on the Selinda Spillway where prolific wildlife awaits, this camp is safari-chic at its best.



Duba Explorers Camp

This intimate camp consists of six expedition-style tents with views of the surrounding floodplain. Each tent has a small desk and private verandah plus en-suite facilities consisting of flush loo, double basins and indoor shower. The main area is under sweeping marquis canvas, on raised decking opens to the outdoors on all sides. Duba Explorers Camp prides itself on its extraordinary wildlife experiences.

Duba Plains Camp & Duba Suite

Remote as it is legendary. Great Plains Conservation founders, Dereck and Beverly Joubert call this their home because it is the very essence of wild, untrammelled Africa at its most exciting. See the famous lions of Duba Plains, some of the largest left in Africa. The camps are a testament to tasteful and sophisticated luxury making them an essential destination for the discerning naturalist and safari enthusiast.



Kenya

Mara Plains Camp

Mara Plains Camp is located on a bend in the Ntiakitiak River in the heart of the 35,000-acre Olare Motorogi Conservancy which abuts Kenya's Maasai Mara National Reserve. This small, high quality, seven-roomed camp under canvas sits on raised decks with sweeping views across Kenya's notable savannahs. It boasts the region's lowest vehicle density with no mini-buses, and only one guest room per 700 acres! Mara Plains is the perfect camp from which to experience The Great Migration.

Mara Expedition Camp

Mara Expedition Camp, offering affordable Kenyan safari experiences, is positioned on high ground in a grove of typical East African acacia trees overlooking a valley in the Maasai Mara Reserve. It is on private land, offering exclusivity with access to some of the region's best wildlife. Wildlife drives are in Kenya's Maasai Mara Reserve and the private Mara North Conservancy. The camp tells the story of early explorers to Africa with campaign furniture and open air space under light canvas. It is an ideal camp to start your safari looking for big cats such as cheetah and lion.

Mara Toto Camp

When we designed Mara Toto Camp, a perfect camp from which to enjoy your Masai Mara safari, it was based on an original 19th-century styled expedition camp with light canvas and high apex tents, supported by huge gum-poles. Right along the river's edge and under some of the most spectacular ebony trees, its position creates a hidden haven to retire between exciting safari drives. This small 8-bed camp is ideal for families, or small parties, explorers, adventurers and photographers. Nearby leopard and lion's calls are often heard from this safari camp. This camp is seasonal and open during select months of the year.




Ol Donyo Lodge

Located on the slopes of the Chyulu Hills National Park between the Amboseli and Tsavo West National Parks in southeast Kenya, its location is unrivalled with full views of Mount Kilimanjaro and situated in the path of traditional wildlife migration routes. This lodge offers a host of extra complimentary activities such as horse riding, mountain biking, negotiating lava tubes, Masai Village visits, hides and sleep outs and more.

Mara Nyika Camp

Mara Nyika, meaning "Large Plains or Great Plains" is an intimate four tent camp set in a valley straddling a small stream on the western side of the Naboisho Conservancy bordering the Maasai Mara.

The tents sit under the canopy of umbrella thorn trees, offering guests views out over the plains with one of the most spectacular backdrops Africa can provide. Mara Nyika allows guests to explore the private and exclusive wildlife-rich 50,000-acre Naboisho Conservancy. Wildlife experiences from our 3 Mara camps are unique and each offers a different face of the incredible Maasai Mara ecosystem.



Zimbabwe

Mpala Jena Camp - Victoria Falls

Mpala Jena is located on the white sandy edges of Zimbabwe's Zambezi River and in the Zambezi National Park. It combines the elements of both by using thatched roofs in the main areas and flowing canvas luxury tents for the bedrooms. The sand floor in the bar area, and the adjacent swimming pool, set the scene for guests to kick their shoes off and relax after their morning game drive or river cruise. The pool lounge makes you feel that you are right on the river and is the ideal place to hang out with a book during the heat of the day. Mpala Jena is highly sought after for those wanting unique, exclusive Victoria Falls accommodation.



Sapi Private Reserve

The Mana Pools National Park and neighbouring private Sapi Concession form part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Following the conversion of the Sapi Safari area to a private photographic reserve in 2016, together the two comprise of 337,600 hectares of prime protected wilderness along the mighty Zambezi River and are recognised as one of the finest in Africa.

With an estimated 85% of these two wildlife areas only traversable on foot, this is Africa's dream walking safari destination.

Tembo Plains Camp & Tembo Suite

Tembo Plains Camp and Suite fit into our highest camp level offering, the Réserve Collection of camps. The camp has four double or twin bed configuration suites. Each has its own private indoor lounge area, outdoor swimming pool (with exercise bikes on an expansive veranda) and outdoor dining area. Stunning, handmade bathtubs with indoor and outside showers give the suite a sense of 'home' where you can move in and live. The Wi-Fi and working areas also provide space for you to catch up on business or manage your images from the day's adventures. Each suite comes complete with a professional camera and lenses. High-quality binoculars are also available for guests to use whilst they are with us in the Sapi Reserve. All these little touches deliver the ultimate luxury Zimbabwe safari.






Caribbea Bay Resort – Kariba


